Belvís de Monroy

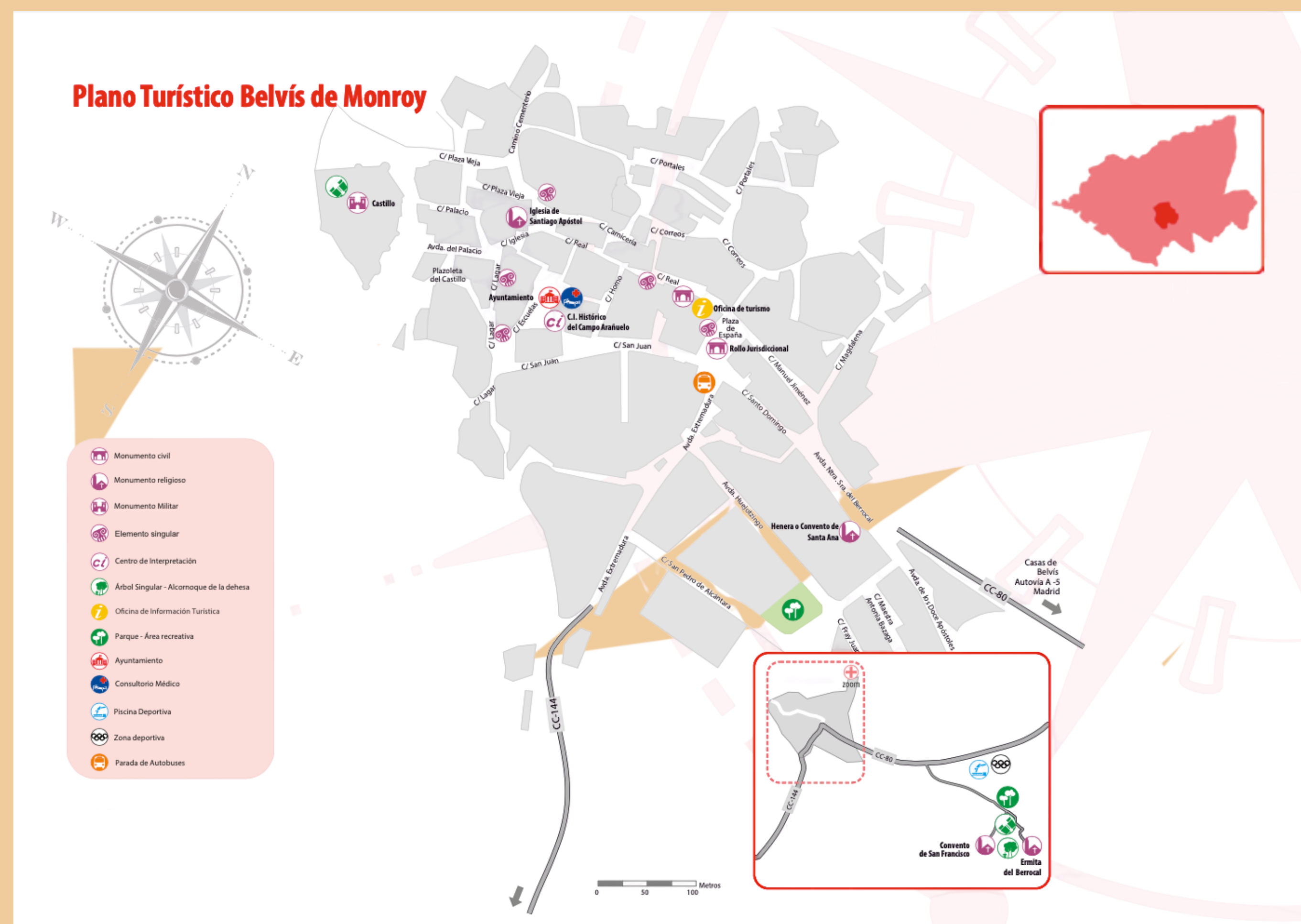
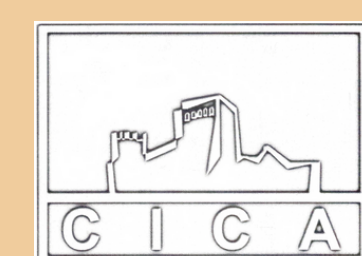
